Free Paper/ e-Poster/ Flex Poster Participation Guidelines:

Eligibility Criteria:

- Only an ISA member or ISA Associate member or attendee awaiting ISA membership are eligible to submit abstract and participate in e-Poster/ Flex Poster presentation / Free Paper.
- The presenter should register for CME and CONFERENCE to do e-Poster/ Poster/ Free Paper presentation.
- All Anaesthesia post-graduate students should submit Bonafide certificate from the HOD of the corresponding institutes.
- Abstracts can only be submitted by email to <u>isakodai2020@gmail.com</u> with the **confirmed** conference registration number.
- The final date for abstract submission for the above event is **15-05-2020**.
- The final date for submitting soft copy(in the form of 8 powerpoint slidesincluding title, author and thanks slides) of e-Poster by e-mail is 25-05-2020.
- e-Poster/ Flex Poster presentation / Free Paper scientific content must be original in nature and should not have been published or presented in previous CME and Conference.
- It is mandatory for the first (main) author to be the presenting author and the award will only be presented to the first author.
- Candidates whose abstracts have been accepted/rejected will be intimated via e-mail only.
- In case of any controversy, the decision of scientific committee shall be final.

Abstract Format Guidelines:

Studies will ONLY be taken for Free paper presentation and case reports for e-Poster/flex poster presentation. Case reports will not be allowed in the free paper section.

Guidelines for preparing abstract for flex poster and e-poster:

Word Limit: The abstract must be within 250 words (Note: Graphs/tables/Images should not

to be included in the abstract).

Language: Abstract must be typed and presented in English.

Font Type: Abstracts should be prepared in Microsoft Word, Times New Roman Font, 12 point with single line spacing, with the title in boldface.

Content:

1. Objective: State the main objective of the presentation.

- 2. Materials and methods: Briefly describe the design of the study and how it was conducted.
- 3. Results: Present the main results with appropriate statistics.
- 4. Conclusion: Limit the conclusions to those that are directly supported by the results.
- 5. Scanned copy of Institutional Ethical Committee (IEC) approval letter.
- 6. Abstract must be sent within 15.5.2020.
- 7. Those presenting the e-poster should sent their completed powerpoint slides including title, author and thanks slides. (8 in number) within 25.05.20.

They can add a video clip (if they desire) of 15 seconds(maximum) duration. The video clip must be in "wmv" format. It must be sent as a separate file along with the ppt file. These slides will be converted into a movie and will be displayed continuously in the hall at the stipulated time. The presenter should be present near the display when the judges make the rounds.

Guidelines Free Paper preparation:

All Free papers will be allowed for Podium presentation.

Language: Free Paper must be typed and presented in English.

Content:

- 1. Title
- 2. Introduction
- 3. Methodology
- 4. Results
- 5. Discussion
- 6. Conclusion.

The presenter will be provided an overall time of 8 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for discussion.

Scientific committee will select 20 free papers for the **PRIZE PAPER CATEGORY** and they will be asked to present on 20th June 2020. 10 papers will be scheduled in the morning session and another 10 will be in the afternoon. The selected prize papers will be intimated through website. **Those papers registered in CTRI will be given preference.** The best 3 papers will be given the ISA sponsored cash prize awards.

The rest of the papers will be called "FREE PAPERS" and will be scheduled separately. Best 3 papers will be selected from the free paper category and honoured.

Guidelines for preparing Flex Poster:

- This category will include separate presentations for Post-graduates and Practitioners.
- The dimension for the flex poster should be 4 feet height and 3 feet width.
- The first author should be available in person during presentation to judges on specific date

and time which will be informed through website.

 Please check and be present at your allocated time slot for the poster judging. The presenter

will be provided an overall time of 5 minutes for presentation and 3 minutes for discussion.

Prizes:

- 1. The best three **PRIZE** papers will be selected for prize by the judges and awarded the ISA city branches sponsored cash awards.
- 2. The best two **FREE** papers will be selected for prize by the judges in each session and **certificates** will be issued in the hall itself.
- 3. The best three **FLEX POSTERS** presentation **3 presenters** will be selected for prize by the judges.
- 4. The best three **e-Posters** presentation **3 Presenters** will be selected for prize by the judges.
